An Inspiration to the Hospitality Industry



Michael was a tireless visionary and a devoted advocate for Philadelphia's rising hospitality industry. Everyone who knew him admired his energy.

He had a lifelong passion for Philadelphia. He grew up savvy and street-smart in the Grays Ferry section. Early on, he came to see his hometown was a place not only of long historical traditions, but also of unlimited opportunity for the future.

He was a key figure in the revival of Philadelphia's hospitality industry. In 1993, he and his partners at Valley Forge Investment Corp. bought the Omni at Independence Park where Mike served as GM until his death. He served as president of the Greater Philadelphia Hotel Association from 1998 to 2000 and was a founding member of the Greater Philadelphia Tourism Marketing Corporation.

To honor his vitality and dedication to his profession, in 2001 the Greater Philadelphia Hotel Association established a scholarship fund in his memory. The Michael M. Boyle Scholarship Fund, managed by The Philadelphia Foundation, supports high school and college hospitality students who display determination to achieve academic success, to work hard, and to pursue their dreams. Partial proceeds from the golf outing support the Michael M. Boyle scholarship fund. Scholarships are awarded at our annual luncheon held in December.
