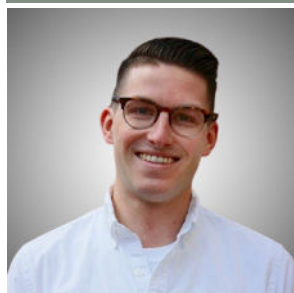


Stephen Madsen, M.C.R.P.
